Our Handover Ceremony was organied at Merit Park Hotel early July 2020. Due to Covid-19 restirictions only our members were invited to attend the ceremony. We would like to take this opportunity to thank PP Behiye Müftüzade for all her efforts to manage our club during difficult times. We would also like to thank our AG Vural Vural for showing his support and attending our handover ceremony. We are now looking forward to our new term with the presidency of Anja Van Raam.

Following the devasteding fire in Kalkanlı and Korucam on 17th of May 2020 with a toll of 11,000 acres of forestry burned including ancient olive trees. Our Rotary member Ayten organised a fundraising birthday party where all proceeds were tunneled through Rotary Club of Kyrenia Cosmopolitan to fund the reforestation of the burned areas.

MERITTA SEA TURTLE REHABILITATION CENTER



IT'S TIME FOR BARBECUE...




All proceeds went towards our projects supporting underpriviled and disabled young people.

As the whole world has been living with the impact of COVID 19 and trying to find different ways to live life as "normal" the Rotary Club of Kyrenia Cosmopolitan has also been forced to find creative ways to ensure our club continues to function and to raise the much needed funds for the projects we support.

As a way forward, we decided to ensure our board meetings were taking place either in open air or well ventilated spacious venues. We also made good use of technology and provided our board members the option of joining meetings via zoom. We set up what's up groups to share information with all the Rotary members and ensured that channels of communication were open so all members could continue to feel a part of a team.

These processes enabled us to meet, discuss, plan and finally deliver the successful fund raising events which not only supported the projects for vulnerable young people as identified in our annual plan but also respond to unexpected environmental catastrophes both in our country and abroad.

During the COVID 19 lockdown, we contacted the local municipality who identified families who were in desperate need, we prepared and delivered 65 food parcels to these families. We delivered additional food packages to needy families with special needs children. Through the Vakif "Trust", we provided clothing, food packages as well as cash to families including some living in Nicosia who were in most need. Through the local university we identified and supported 12 overseas students who were desperately in need of money for food.

We raised funds towards the reforestation following the fire in Kalkanli Cyprus. We also reached out with financial support across our borders to countries who faced unexpected crisis such as Lebanon following the explosion and more recently the earthquake in Izmir.

We are now, together with our local municipality in the planning process towards the development of a recycling and biodegradable project.

Rotary Club of Kyrenia Cosmopolitan members have shown their commitment to the Rotary International motto.
