

What is Polio?

Poliomyelitis is highly infectious disease that most commonly affects children under the age of 5. Most know it as poliovirus. The virus is spread to person, typically through contaminated water. It can attack the nervous system, and in some instances, lead to paralysis. Although there is no cure, there is a safe and effective vaccine - one which Rotary and our partners use to immunize over 2.5 billion children worldwide.



5 FACTS ABOUT POLIO

1.Polio mainly affects children under age 5. 2. There is no cure, but Polio is preventable with a vaccine. 3.Only three countries remain endemic. 4.Rotary, along with partners, had reduced cases by 99.9% since 1988. 5.Until we end polio forever,

every child is at risk.



When the Global Polio Eradication Initiative was started in 1985, polio paralyzed more than 350,000 children annually in more than 125 countries. Now, the number of cases has decreased by 99%. India had its last new case of polio in 2011. Now the disease is considered endemic, or prevalent, in just three countries: Nigeria, Afghanistan and Pakistan. In 2016 there were fewer than 40 new cases diagnosed in those countries. And so far, this year, there have only new diagnoses Afghanistan and Pakistan; none in Nigeria.




GRANT MANAGEMENT SEMINAR AND CYPRUS ASSEMBLY






All the proceeds from this event will be donated to special needs children within our community and to the World Polio Fund to assist with the eradication of polio.

Rotary Club of Kyrenia Cosmopolitan, organised a Christmas Party on Tuesday 11th December at the 18+ rehabilitation centre in Karakum, providing them with a host of presents and prizes. Esen Karaç who is a special needs educational teacher of music, provided the entertainment and co-ordinated the party games.

This centre facilitates up to 25 individuals ranging from the age of 18 to 40. These men and women suffer from a complex of disabilities, ranging from mental health issues to physical disabilities. The event was sponsored by the Merit International Group who provided all the catering facilities to an extremely high standard. The proposed development which is also going to be sponsored by the Merit International Group, with the help of the Kyrenia Municipality, is to improve their facilities within the present building and to reconstruct, develop and secure their surrounding grounds. This will involve the preparation of pitches where a variety of sports can be played, which will help with their rehabilitation.
