Με μεγάλη θλίψη, ο Όμιλος αποχαιρέτησε στις 21/09/2011 το ιδρυτικό μέλος του Ομίλου μας, **Ροταριανό Σόλων Ζεβλάρη** ο οποίος απεβίωσε στις 19/09/2011. Στην νεκρώσιμη ακολουθία που πραγματοποιήθηκε στην Εκκλησία Της Του Θεού Σοφία στο Στρόβολο κατατέθηκε στεφάνι εις μνήμη του εκλιπόντος ενώ παρευρέθηκαν και μέλη του Ομίλου μας.

Ο Πρόεδρος ζήτησε όπως τηρηθεί μονόλεπτη σιγή εις μνήμη του Ροτ. Σόλων Ζεβλάρη ως ελάχιστο φόρο τιμής για την προσφορά του στον Όμιλο. Institutes are informational meetings and may be organized for a zone, a section of a zone, or a grouping of zones.

- 1) Provide current, incoming, and past RI officers with updates on RI and Rotary Foundation policies and programs
- 2) Provide a forum for Rotary leaders to make comments and recommendations to the Board of Directors
- 3) Provide fellowship and a participative learning experience that will help inspire current, incoming, and past governors to continuing leadership and service

Our District has the honor to be hosting such a prestigious gathering for the first time this year. Last year the Zone Institute was held in Sofia, Bulgaria and before that in Istanbul, Turkey. # Rotary's support for polio eradication making a key difference

Rotary International has played a major role in helping the Global Polio Eradication Initiative make continued progress and overcome obstacles in the drive to rid the world of the disease.

Since October 2010, Rotary has provided almost US\$40 million for polio surveillance, immunization campaigns, and technical assistance in several countries. In India, only one case of polio has been reported since January of this year.

"My country has benefited greatly from your support and I thank all of you," said Ghulam Nabi Azad, India's minister of health and family welfare, speaking to Rotary leaders and staff at RI head-quarters in Evanston, Illinois, USA, on 23 September. He credited Rotary with "not only the mobilization of funds, but the active participation of Rotarians in the field with our operations" for helping his country near the goal of polio eradication.

"Rotary has invested heavily in surveillance in India over the last 12 months," said Bruce Aylward, the World Health Organization's assistant director-general for polio eradication and related areas, at a mid-September meeting of Rotary's International PolioPlus Committee. "That's the reason we can say with confidence that we think we're getting close to zero [cases] in India."

#### **Endemic countries**

The wild poliovirus (types 1 and 3) is endemic in only four countries: Afghanistan, India, Nigeria, and Pakistan. Nigeria has maintained a 95 percent drop in polio cases in the past 24 months. Even though the number of cases in Pakistan has increased by 70 percent in 2011 compared to last year, only one case of type 3 polio has been reported.

"[Rotary's] funding for Pakistan has helped us to bring type 3 to the verge of eradication in all of Asia," Aylward said.

After transmission of the wild poliovirus had been reestablished in Angola and Southern Sudan, Rotary's support for immunization campaigns made a critical difference in stopping them, he said.

Rotary helped stem the tide in the Republic of the Congo as well. Calling the spike in polio cases there "the worst, most fatal outbreak we had seen in years," Aylward said that Rotary's funding spurred both government action and substantial support from other donors.

Rotary is also funding research to evaluate new vaccine strategies and how they can enhance the quality of immunization campaigns.

Over the last 12 months, Rotary's investments in polio eradication "underpinned the largest coordinated public health operations in the world," Aylward said. "They leveraged the use of 1.7 billion

doses of OPV [oral polio vaccine] to vaccinate 400 million kids in 183 campaigns in 47 countries. They were right on the mark, and all of them can be linked to real progress."

## **Public Relations Plan**

#### **Public Relations Plan**

#### Main target:

To get more citizens aware, especially whose who leave in Nicosia area, about our club, and our activities. What is Rotary, who are the Rotarians, what does Rotary do. Specifically, we should try to overcome and to clarify a misunderstanding and a misperception that runs across a lot of people in Cyprus that Rotary is a kind of a "sect" (heresy). This is a quite negative approach from a lot of people in Cyprus that affects the expansion, the role and the function of our club and our organization in general, especially in Cyprus a country with citizens that have very strong bonds to their religion. Also, we should sick and aim to expose and to promote most of our major activities, through the media (local and national).

#### Use of media:

In our days the use of media, especially electronic media, is a very powerful, important and effective tool (and vehicle) in order to promote and to inform the public about our organizations and our club's activities. We are listing below some of our initial suggestions regarding the promotion of our club's activities through the media:

- Prepare and send press (news) releases to all media (electronic and printed) regarding our major activities.
- Arrange the participation of our President and/or other Board members to various local radio programs, in order to speak and to explain the role, the function and the importance of our organization and especially our Nicosia-Lefkothea club.
- Inform the media (especially some "key" media

persons and journalists) but also the public, in general, about our official web-side, so they can visit it and get the appropriate information. They could also have a link to our weekly electronic bulletin in order to follow our meeting activities and other general activities and projects of our club.

#### Events that could be attractive to the media:

We should organize specific events that are attractive both to the media and to the general public.

Such events could be "tea - afternoons", dinners, special "theme" nights, or special nights (parties) at a local night club (such event could be also attractive to younger people). We can also organize special events like a Christmas Gala dinner, a Carnival dance dinner, a Saint Valentine's Day special dinner, an Easter lunch day, out in the fields, with the traditional lamb "suvla", etc. We can invite one or two notable, expert speakers (according to specific subjects and fields) well known Doctor, or a well known media personality, to give a speech thus, organizing an event open to the general public. For all these events and activities we can always collaborate with other local clubs.

#### **Local government officials:**

We could arrange meetings of our Board Members with high positioned local government officials in order to inform them about our activities, our efforts to support and to help the society through our charity activities and events and to make them aware about our existence and our function, especially in the district of Nicosia. Such meetings will be largely covered by the media.
