3. World Polio Day- Illumination of the Nicosia Municipal Theatre - 24 October 2021

The World Polio Day for the year 2021 was celebrated with a mega- event held at the Municipal Theater of Nicosia on the evening of the 24th October 2021.

The event was organized by our Club and supported by all Nicosia-based Clubs: Nicosia Salamis, Rotary Club of Nicosia, Rotary Club Nicosia Aspelia Rotary Club of Nicosia-Ledra and Rotary Club of Kyrenia. The event was under the auspices of the H.E. the Minister of Foreign Affairs Mr. Nicos Christodoulides and was attended by over 80 Rotarians and guests, including foreign ambassadors and the leadership team of Cyprus Rotary. It was a celebration day for Cyprus Rotary!

The program included a welcoming address by the President of our Club Yiannis Tomasides, a speech by the President of the Cyprus Medical Association Dr. Petros Agathangelou on the medical aspect of polio, a speech by PDDG Iacovos Constantinides on the role of Rotary International in eradicating polio, an address by the Minister of Foreign Affairs to the event and ultimately the illumination of this iconic building with the colours of the "End Polio Now" campaign, which was the highlight of the event. A cocktail reception concluded this beautiful evening.

The event attracted media attention as well: A video coverage in the central news program of CYBC on the day and an extensive article in the electronic version of the Phileleftheros newspaper the day after (please see below).








Φωταγώγηση του Δημοτικού Θεάτρου Λευκωσίας στα χρώματα της διεθνούς εκστρατείας του Rotary «End Polio Now»

Η 24η Οκτωβρίου, η οποία θεσμοθετήθηκε από το Διεθνές Ρόταρυ ως η διεθνής Ημέρα κατά της ασθένειας της πολιομυελίτιδας, εορτάστηκε με εκδήλωση που διοργάνωσε ο Ροταριανός Όμιλος Λευκωσία-Λευκοθέα με την στήριξη των Ροταριανών Ομίλων «Λευκωσία», «Λευκωσία-Ασπέλια», «Λευκωσία-Λήδρα», «Λευκωσία-Σάλαμις» και «Κερύνεια» στον προαύλιο χώρο του Δημοτικού Θεάτρου Λευκωσίας την Κυριακή 24 Οκτωβρίου 2021. Η εκδήλωση τελούσε υπό την αιγίδα του Υπουργού Εξωτερικών κ. Νίκου Χριστοδουλίδη. Την εκδήλωση τίμησαν επίσης με την παρουσία τους πρέσβεις ξένων χωρών καθώς και η ηγεσία του Κυπριακού Ρόταρυ.



Στην εισαγωγική του ομιλία ο Πρόεδρος του Ροταριανού Ομίλου Λευκωσία-Λευκοθέα κ. Γιάννης Τομασίδης τόνισε ότι η εξάλειψη της ασθένειας της πολιομυελίτιδας υπήρξε από τη δεκαετία του 1980 μια από τις κυριότερες αποστολές του Διεθνούς Ρόταρυ. Η αποστολή αυτή στέφεται με επιτυχία αφού η πολυομελίτιδα έχει εξαλειφθεί κατά 99% παγκοσμίως, παρόλα αυτά, όπως ανέφερε, η προσπάθεια των Ροταριανών θα ολοκληρωθεί με την οριστική της εξάλειψη της ασθένειας.

Στην δική του τοποθέτηση ο Πρόεδρος του Παγκύπριου Ιατρικού Συλλόγου Δρ. Πέτρος Αγαθαγγέλου ανέλυσε την πολιομυελίτιδα από ιατρικής σκοπιάς και σύνεδεσε την πανδημία της πολυομελίτιδας με αυτήν του κορωνοϊού τονίζοντας ότι μια πανδημία παραμένει πάντα επικίνδυνη εφόσον αυτή δεν έχει εξαλειφθεί πλήρως.



Ο Πρώην Αναπληρωτής Κυβερνήτης Περιφέρειας του Ρόταρυ 2452 κ. Ιάκωβος Κωνσταντινίδης στην δική του ομιλία ανέδειξε την σημαντικότητα του έργου του Διεθνούς Ρόταρυ για την καταπολέμηση της νόσου, το οποίο, στα πλαίσια της συμμετοχής του ως ιδρυτικό μέλος του φορέα «Global Polio Eradication Initiative», διέθεσε μέχρι σήμερα 2,2 δισεκατομμύρια δολάρια για το σκοπό αυτό. Ανέφερε ότι σήμερα μόνο δύο χώρες παραμένουν ενδημικές, το Αφγανιστάν και το Πακιστάν. Ανέδειξε τέλος την αποφασιστικότητα των Ροταριανών να συνεχίσουν την προσπάθεια τους μέχρι την οριστική εξάλειψη της ασθένειας.



Στην δική του τοποθέτηση ο Υπουργός Εξωτερικών εξήρε το έργο του Διεθνούς Ρόταρυ τονίζοντας τον καθοριστικό του ρόλο στην αντιμετώπιση της ασθένειας της πολυομελίτιδας. Έκανε επίσης ειδική αναφορά στον ρόλο του Κυπριακού Ρόταρυ ως ένα φωτεινό παράδειγμα αρμονικής συνύπαρξης και παραγωγικής συνεργασίας Ελληνοκυπρίων και Τουρκοκυπρίων, οργανωμένων σε ροταριανούς ομίλους στις ελεύθερες και τις κατεχόμενες περιοχές, ως ένα ενιαίο σύνολο υπό μια κοινή ηγεσία, αποτελώντας έτσι θεσμό που στέλνει ένα ισχυρό μήνυμα για ένα καλύτερο αύριο για την πατρίδα μας. Έκανε επίσης αναφορά στο γενικότερο ρόλο που επιτελεί το Κυπριακό Ρόταρυ στην κοινωνία των πολιτών μέσω της ενεργής συμμετοχής πολιτών σε δράσεις που στοχεύουν σε ένα καλύτερο κόσμο.



Ακολούθησε η φωταγώγηση του κτηρίου από τον Υπουργό Εξωτερικών κ. Νίκο Χριστοδουλίδη στα χρώματα της εκστρατείας του Διεθνούς Ροταρυ «End Polio Now".

4. District Governor's Visit in Cyprus: 8-14 November

Our District Governor (DG) Ashot Karapetyan visited Cyprus in the week 8-14 November 2021 and had the opportunity to meet all Clubs across the island.

As part of his schedule, the DG had a meeting with representatives from the Nicosia-based Clubs on the 9th of November at Prosilio restaurant. Our Club had a significant representation by a number of members: President Yiannis Tomasides, PDDG Iacovos Constantinides, PDDG George Psimolophites, PP Popi Kanari, PP Paris Constantinou who was the Sergeant at arms of the event, PP Demetris Pantazis, Vice President Vasilis Polemitis, Secretary George Thucydides and Rotarians Maria Xenophontos, Panayiota Georgiou and Tania Eojourian.

DG expressed his joy for being in Cyprus and praised Cyprus Rotary for its work and important achievements. He highlighted the goals for the Rotarian Year and invited all Rotarians to the District conference taking place in Yerevan, Armenia in May 2022.

As part of the event, PDDG Iacovos Constantinides and PP Demetris Pantazis were awarded the Paul Harris Fellow (PHF) recognition by the DG who did the pinning. This was an awarding which was outstanding from the latest handover ceremony in July 2021. In his address, President Yiannis Tomasides mentioned the following: *"The Board of RC Nicosia-Lefkothea has decided the award of PHF to the PDDG Iacovos Constantinides and Immediate PP Demetris Pantazis in recognition of their outstanding contribution to Rotary and for the successful further development and cohesion of our Rotary Club. Through the contribution and hard work of these two fellow Rotarians and of all our members we have made as our Club a truly vibrant Club".*













Visit of the District Governor to the Karaiskakio foundation

On 11th November 2021, the District Governor visited the Karaiskakio foundation as one of the main beneficiaries of Rotary in Cyprus. He was accompanied by the Vice-Governor Kevork Mahdessian and the Deputy District Governor Peter Ashdjian. On behalf of our Club, DG and his delegation were welcomed by PP and President of the Board of Directors of Karaiskakio foundation Dr. Popi Kanari, PDDG Iacovos Constantinides, President Yiannis Tomasides and Immediate PP Demetris Pantazis. The Executive Director of the foundation Dr. Costeas Pavlos was also present in a meeting held at the Karaiskakio premises.

During the meeting, the DG was presented the history of Karaiskakio and the significant work it produces at both local and international levels, by Dr Popi Kanari and Dr. Pavlos Costeas.

DG was also presented the two recent Global Grant projects materialized by our Club for Karaiskakio foundation:

- The establishment of a Childhood cancer diagnostic Centre at the Karaiskakio Foundation - Cellular Biomarker detection unit in 2019.
- The enhancement of the Resources and Effectiveness of the Integrated Childhood Cancer Diagnostic Unit at the Karaiskakio Foundation in 2020.

The DG was very impressed and urged our Rotary Club to consider including Karaiskakio foundation in a proposal targeting a mega Global Grand project (value: one million US dollars+). At the end of his visit, the DG was given a tour at the Karaiskakio premises and was shown the equipment purchased through the Global Grant.





9. From our Club Board meetings

In this section, the most important matters discussed and decided at our monthly Club Board meetings, are presented.

During October our Club Board met on 5th October 2021, with the following key outcome:

District Awards	Vassilis Polemitis will act as the coordinator of the District Awards and will be in touch with the Directors of Avenues.
Service Projects	1. Makarion Hospital PP Dr. Popi Kanari briefed participants about her visit at the hospital. Mr. Neofytou, the Chief Doctor provided ample details on the needs of the hospital regarding both equipment and training required for junior nurses. The estimated cost of the outlined needs is between €15.000 - €20.000.
	2. "Ithaki" foundation PP Panikos Nicolaides and Rot. Maria Saparilla visited "Ithaki", however they were not provided with their specific needs for the time being.
	3. Foni Foundation President Yiannis Tomasides has talked with "Foni" and is waiting for their feedback.
	4. Children's park at Strovolos PP Demetris Pantazis mentioned that there was not any response from the Mayor of Strovolos Municipality. He suggested, if we are to proceed with the idea of the park for the Municipality, our Club to fund up to €5.000, while the rest €15.000 should come from sponsors (e.g. Banks), as the total estimated budget is €20.000. The Board approved the amount of €5.000 to be committed in the Club's bank account for this project, in case the project materializes in the future.

	The project will not proceed eventually, not least due to lack of interest from Strovolos Municipality.

	They requested a bus of €25.000 value.
	6. Hope for Children
	€1.000 for a bookshelf and books are required. Vice President Vasilis Polemitis is in contact with them
	PP Panicos Nicolaides, Director of Community Service Projects mentioned
	that feedback from ITHAKI is a prerequisite for the Community Service Projects Team to complete their report based on which the Board will be asked to make the final decision on the 2021-22 Community Service project.
