## The visit of the RC of Cambridge Rutherford to our club.

A lot of preparation was made to welcome the Rotary Club of Cambridge Rutherford on the  $10_{th}$  of March 2020.

Indeed, we planned to take them to the Karaiskakio Foundation to see the work done by the Foundation with emphasis on the Rotary contribution to the Childhood Cancer Diagnostic Centre, a sights tour of Nicosia in the afternoon, a pub visit (Murphy's) 'to freshen up' and a taverna evening with live music where we would also exchange banners.

Regrettably it was on the  $10_{th}$  of March that Covid – 19 made its 'public' appearance in Cyprus and justifiably we were all worried not only for ourselves but also for our visitors.

Despite the difficult circumstances we did manage to complete an important part of the programme.

Initially I accompanied the Group to the Karaiskakio where we were met by our Fellow Rotarian PP Popi Kanari in her capacity as Chairperson of the KF and Dr. Pavlos Costeas the CEO. Our Guests were very impressed with our Rotary project and for the work done by the KF and its world ranking. They found the visit very exciting and congratulated all those involved.

In the afternoon we arranged a professional guide through PDDG Elena Tanou (at no cost to our club) who took the Group to the Leventis Museum and to various sights in Nicosia. Again, the Group found the tour very informative and congratulated the guide Ms. Georgia Constanti.

By the end of their tour, a number of our members called me to express their worry about going out to the taverna and the decision was taken to cancel the taverna evening.

This was communicated to the Group who were very understanding.

We then decided to exchange banners on the pavement adjacent to the OXI roundabout. The exchange was also attended by AG PP Petros Stylianou. We also gave them a gift from the Handicraft Centre to commemorate their visit to our Club.

Although not the most desirable venue, I am sure it is a Rotary first to exchange banners by the side of the road, on the pavement!

Worth mentioning that the visit of RC Cambridge Rutherford to Cyprus was organised by PP George Fisher who is of Cypriot roots and acted as the liaison between the two clubs
