Scholarships :

- 2. Andreas Michael Combined Grade 18.75 Nurse School 4th year now. For one year 1500 Euro
- 3. Andria Masia Nursery Governess University of Ioannina 1500 Euro once off.

The scholarships as shown above were approved by the club.
