Guest Speaker:

Officially invited by DG Kevork Mahdessian, Dr Moez El Shohdi, CEO and co-founder of the Egyptian Food Bank visited Nicosia and attended the last Intercity meeting of this Rotary year, arranged by RC Nicosia Aspelia.

Moez El Shodi was introduced by DG Kevork Mahdessian. Dr. Moez El Shohdi, CEO and co-founder of the EFB, is leading the charge for developing food banks throughout the Middle East and North Africa (MENA), and Pakistan. He is recognized for his work to develop and promote unique solutions through EFB that address hunger as a way to lift people out

We had the opportunity to listen to a very interesting presentation on how a Food Bank operates and responds to the needs of the society. It all started with a group of businessmen who decided to fight the hunger in Egypt. The country has already many charity organisations and one more was not needed; it had to be done differently. It was decided to save wasted food and support the disabled, people not able to work, single mothers and elderly people.

The program got a lot of publicity and became controversial. Many wanted to discontinue the project but Moez El Shohdi did not give up and drove it forward.. Foodbank has now been running for 7 years and is a great success, also in other countries such as Saudi, Lebanon, Jordan, Iraqi, Syria, Tunisia, Emirate and Pakistan. All hotels are following the program and many volunteers make it possible. Rotary clubs are involved and altogether there are 45 000 volunteers. Many upcoming Foodbanks are planned, for instance in Sudan, Yemen, Bahrain, Libya, Morocco, Kenya and Congo. Perhaps Cyprus can be the next. This was for our Rotary clubs, food for thoughts indeed.
