Club Assembly

1. Financial Report

Treasurer Walter Bopp informed that with a healthy financial status, we have been able to make a good budget reducing the membership fee for 2013/14. The sum which will be forwarded on the Operational Account will be approx. €4000.00.

On the Community Account, taking into consideration the actual balance, the income of P Eleni's Party and the subsequent contribution to Polio Plus (\$500.00) there will be a surplus of approximately €500.00 for the year 2013/14.

The Emergency Account €320.00.

The Scholarship Accounts €3980.00 will be forwarded to the year 2013/14.

Donation 300 euro

It was today the birthday of Treasurer Walter and he kindly donated €300 to the scholarship fund. All Aspelia members thanked him for his generosity and celebrated his birthday by singing to him.

2. Rotary Foundation Club Memorandum of Understanding

P Eleni informed about the new Rotary Foundation Club Memorandum of Understanding. If the Club wishes to apply for the new Rotary Foundation Grants schemes, we need to sign the Memorandum.

The Board of Directors decided at the previous Board meeting to sign and thus we commit ourselves to apply properly (the MOU form had been sent by email to all members).

3. Aspelia Meetings

PE Loucas Vrionides is discussing with Hilton about better quotations and the proposal from the last Board Meeting, to be confirmed by the fist Club Assembly of the new Rotary year, is:

Continue with evening meetings and the 5th Thursday, when applicable, to be a Fellowship lunch, or to have an extra Fellowship lunch every month.

The main reason to keep the evening meetings is to attract younger members and in particular the Aspelia Rotaractors that are ready to become Rotarians.

DG Kevork proposed that Rotary Clubs keep his office for meetings and to share the cost of rent. There was a proposal that the Cyprus Rotary, DDGE Chirstina Covotsos elaborates on this issue and comes back with a suggestion to all clubs. A discussion followed and it will be decided on the DDG Change over ceremony, July 12.

4. Membership fee

There will be a reduction of the membership fees, to be €180 and to be paid in two installments for those wishing to. The fee will be €130 and the Rotary Foundation support €50.

5. Membership

Stefan Peter, Alessio Mugnai and Göran Svensson have, due to work, travelling and family reasons, sent their resignation letters and they have been removed from the membership list.

P Eleni sent them thank you messages for their service to the Club and informed them that they would always be welcome to the Aspelia events and meetings.
