President's Announcements:

Before the Club Assembly P Loucas went through the forthcoming calendar of events of the year, in particular he mentioned that:

- On next Friday the 30th of May during our lunch meeting we have a speaker, Prof. Constantinos Christofides the Dean of the University of Cyprus.
- On Saturday 31st of May, we organize jointly with our Rotaractors a Karagiozis Shadow Theatre event at the Bank of Cyprus Cultural Centre. There will be a Workshop at 10:45, at € 5, where kids will create their own shadow theatre figure with original materials. There will be, also, a short documentary and from 12:00 to 13:00 the performance which
