

Message from the Deputy District Governor 2011-12 Themis Themistocleous

Dear fellow Rotarians,

October is packed with significant events and activities, and I urge you to miss none! Mark your calendars and join in:

The 3rd Cyprus Rotary Conference and Assembly takes place on 22-23 October at the Forest Park Hotel in the renowned mountain resort of Platres, where "nightingales do not let you sleep" as Nobel laureate Seferis has written. Our weekend retreat features workshops on The Rotary Foundation. Membership and Public Relations, a keynote speech by the current chairman of the general assembly of WHO Dr Christos Patsalides, visits, exhibitions, and a Saturday night outing. We shall be honoured by the attendance of our District Governor Usama and his spouse Lina Barghouthi, at the start of their official visit to Cyprus. The schedule and the agenda for our Cyprus Clubs' Assembly on Sunday are further down in this newsletter. I once again call on all Rotarians, Rotaractors, and family and friends of Rotary to register and enjoy what the organizing committee promises to be a unique event.

Governor Usama will then begin his visits to the Clubs, rounding up on 3 November. I have sent information and protocol details to the Presidents and Secretaries, together with the schedule, which you may also find further down. His visits will allow him to communicate directly with all Rotarians and Rotaractors in Cyprus, to gain better understanding of the clubs, to provide helpful and friendly advice to club officers as requested, to answer questions about Rotary International and the District, and to serve as a catalyst to help strengthen the programs of Rotary. Let us extend to Usama and Lina our warmest welcome.

Meanwhile, our District will for the first time play host to the **Zone 20B Rotary Institute**, in Cairo, from 11to15 October. Our Zone comprises 26 countries, eight Districts, and more than 700 Clubs. The Institute will provide current, incoming, and past officers with updates on RI and Rotary Foundation policies and programs, offer a forum for Rotary leaders to make comments and recommendations to the Board of Directors. and promote fellowship and a participative learning experience. Three events will take place in sequence: GETS on 11 and 12 October, the Rotary Coordinators' seminar, the Rotary Public Image seminar, and The Rotary Foundation seminar on 13 October, and the Institute on 14 and 15 October. Below you may find details and instructions on how to register.

And, October is Vocational Service Month in the Rotary calendar. I consider this avenue of service as the pillar of Rotary and I feel we could do more to contribute our vocational talents to solving the problems of society and meeting the needs of our communities. I ask Club Presidents to devote the first meeting of the month to examining vocational service in Rotary, including the Four-Way Test and the Declaration of Rotarians in Business and Professions. After expanding members' awareness, you may solicit input in planning projects for the year, including providing vocational and ethical guidance to youth. You may find more information further down in this newsletter.
